  - Ford Transit Connect Cargo Van for food transportation: \$37,000
  - Maintenance/safety improvements for new and existing vehicles: \$4,000
  - Pantry equipment (shelving, hand trucks, freezer): \$5,000
  - IT equipment: \$2,000
  - Community Services Associate: \$36,204 salary + \$11,659 benefits & taxes per year
  - Project total: \$247,863/ 1 year
